### **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR CPD PLATFORM**

Maharashtra Medical Council is a statutory body established by Government of Maharashtra under M.M.C. Act 1965. The working of the Council includes Registration, Administration as well as to follow the guidelines given in the Act and its Rules 1967. It is a quasi-judicial body with a power to punish Registered Medical Practitioners. The first Function of MMC is to provide Registration to Medical graduates in Modern Medicine i.e. Allopathic graduates.

Continuous professional development is an important academic activity of Maharashtra Medical Council, Mumbai. A lot of content is disseminated by MMC every year. However, time constraints, physical presence of the course creator and geographical limitations, pose challenges in uptake and participation to the courses. Hence, digitization of the courses in a way that supports offline sessions and allows for a much wider reach that goes beyond just urban areas and reaches every nook and corner of the country. Digitization allows for on-demand access and promotes level of uniformity and quality control.

Maharashtra Medical Council, Mumbai wishes to launch its own CPD platform to further the education for RMPs by offering access to credible online education with CPD credit points. This will ensure that the entire process of online accredited education and grant of credit points is completely within the end to end regulated control of MMC and accreditation data is protected and not shared with any privately owned third party.

MMC invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from Companies/Trusts/ Societies/ Associations (Applicants) wishing to be considered for the proposed "ONLINE CPD AND CLINICAL REFERENCE PLATFORM" AS WELL AS FULLY MANAGED SERVICES TO MAINTAIN THE PLATFORM AND TO ENABLE SOURCES OF NON-BRANDED AND NON-PARTISAN CONTENT, hereinafter referred to as the solution.

This is a single stage procurement process. The objective of this Request for EOI is to identify and finalize eligible applicants who are interested in providing the proposed solution and have suitable capacity, capability and experience.

Technical Specifications for Webinars for RMPs for CPD:

1. Webinar Platform:

- Develop and provide a robust webinar platform for online interactive education and medical content delivery.
- Support access through PCs and mobile devices.
- Ensure at least one operational instance of the platform in India.
- Enable real-time participation and engagement of RMPs during webinars.

2. Content Management:

- Provide a user-friendly interface for MMC's medical experts/ editors to create, edit, publish and update webinar content without technical expertise.
- Facilitate easy management of multimedia presentations, documents and resources.

3. Platform Customization:

- Allow customization of platform structure, including site navigation, course ordering, pass percentages and module-level access rights.
- Enable flexibility for MMC to adapt the platform to specific requirements and future needs.

4. Ownership and Licensing:

- Grant MMC full ownership and licensing rights to the platform.
- Allow sublicensing to government-owned or charitable organizations without restrictions.
- Ensure no private company branding, instead branded as "MMC Accredited Medical Education Platform."
- Permit sub-licensees to brand the platform under their own names.

5. Content Rights and Data Usage:

- Solution provider should not have content rights, distribution rights or data usage rights for published content unless a medical university, medical college or medical association that owns the content.
