Sub:- Regarding provisional registration in respect of medical students admitted in 2014 under China University.

It is brought to the notice of all concerned that recently the Board of Governors in Supersession of MCI has issued an Advisory regarding accepting of Internship of Foreign Medical Graduates in Ref No. MCI-203(1) (Gen.)/2020-Regn./ 12442 Dated 30.07.2020

In the above Advisory it is stated that the Internship training completed by an Indian National during his / her MBBS course in China was / is acceptable for the purpose of grant of permanent registration under section 13 (3) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. It is not mandatory for such students to do 12-month internship training in India.

The Board of Governors in Supersession of Medical Council of India further stated that, it is in accordance with provisions of Indian Medical Council Act 1956 in respect of MBBS or equivalent primary qualification obtained by an Indian National from any other country also.

The matter was discussed at length by the members in the Executive Committee Meeting dt. 23/10/2020 and the following resolution was passed unanimously;

"that the Internship training completed by an Indian National during his / her MBBS or equivalent course in China or any other foreign country is acceptable for the purpose of grant of permanent registration under section 13 (3) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956."

In lieu of Covid 19 pandemic situation in China, international students of 2014 batch from China has requested to allow them to do partial i.e. remaining internship in India by allowing provisional registration. Secondly, few Universities in China has also provided No objection certificate and prescribed few guidelines for the off campus internship in respect of 2014 batch. Council further observed that Embassy of India Beijing has advised medical students to continue to undertake course either online or off campus.

In view of above reasons, Council in its meeting dt. 27/02/2021 has discussed issue in length and has passed following resolution;

- a) The minimum duration of the course (excluding the period of study of local language) should be 4 ½ years with 75% attendance done with practical training and the course should not be through online mode.**
- b) Provisional registration shall be given to Candidates who wants to do partial internship in Maharashtra provided that the duration of overall internship training should be one year, secondly internship shall be done in the campus and not through online mode.**
- c) Provided that candidates shall fulfil other norms for getting provisional registration.**
- d) Maharashtra Medical Council shall grant provisional Certificate for doing internship programme in Maharashtra subject to fulfilment of norms.**
- e) Candidates shall opt for recognized internship training centre/hospital/college as approved by National Medical Commission.**
- f) Candidates shall obtain required NOC from receiving college/recognized University / DMER / DHS as applicable.**
- g) The final internship certificate should be obtained from parent institute (China) by the candidate and submitted to Maharashtra Medical Council while applying for permanent registration.**
